## **Stickford Charities**

#### Stickford Educational Charity has recently widened its objects as follows:

"To support by financial grants any educational objectives, including for equipment, books, courses and experiences, for people of any age resident in the Parish of Stickford (including those normally resident but attending university or college elsewhere) and means tested if the Trustees in their discretion so require."

The Trustees would welcome applications for any educational grants covered by this wider wording.

**Stickford Relief in Need Charity** exists to provide financial help for those in need living in the parish of Stickford, as well as providing pensioners and others in need at Christmas. The Trustees welcome applications from any resident for assistance with, for example, repair bills, funeral expenses, aids for disabled people etc.

The Charity also once again provides a bus service twice a month - to Boston on the second Wednesday and Horncastle on the fourth Thursday of the month, for those without access to their own transport and those who can show a genuine need to use the service, even if they have their own transport as well. The Charity makes school clothing grants in the summer term to parents of children aged 4-16 (plus older children who still need to wear a school uniform) living in the parish of £75 per child to be spent at the School Uniform Centre in Spilsby or in the school shoe and uniform department at Oldrids Downtown.

The vouchers can be split in £25 amounts between either Oldrids Downtown or the SUS as parents prefer. Please make sure you state how many of each voucher you require when you apply.

Please apply in writing stating the child's name, date of birth and YOUR FULL CONTACT DETAILS to Mrs Pam Bryant, Beauport, Cul-de-sac, Stickford by Sunday 12th June 2022.

Please note that for administrative reasons applications received after **Sunday 12th June 2022** cannot be

considered. No reminders will be given this year.

Applicants will only be notified if their application has **NOT** been successful. Vouchers will be delivered to successful applicants early in July 2022 by the Charity Trustees.

SUS vouchers will have to be spent by the end of September 2022. The Oldrids vouchers can, as usual, and in order to comply with our charitable status, **only** be spent in the following Oldrids Downtown departments: **school clothing and children's shoes.** These departments may not be available at Oldrids over the Christmas period.

If you do not wish to spend your vouchers in the relevant departments at Oldrids Downtown, please do not apply for their vouchers or embarrass staff at Oldrids Downtown by asking them to accept vouchers in other departments.
