STICKFORD PARISH COUNCIL

Thursday 4th May is election day for Parish and District Councils. If you are registered to vote then you will now require photo ID to vote.

Accepted forms of photo ID are:

Passport issued by the UK, any of the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man, a British Overseas Territory, an EEA state or a Commonwealth Country

Driving Licence

A Blue Badge

Older person's bus pass funded by the Government of the UK

Disabled person's bus pass funded by the Government of the UK

Freedom Pass

Scottish National Entitlement Card, 60 and over Welsh Travel Card, Disabled person's Welsh Travel Card

Senior Smartpass issued in Northern Ireland, Registered Blind Smartpass or Blind Person's Smartpass

issued in Northern Ireland, War Disablement Smartpass issued in Northern Ireland

60+ Smartpass issued in Northern Ireland, Half fare Smartpass issued in Northern Ireland

Identity Card bearing the Proof of Age Standards Scheme hologram (a PASS Card)

Biometric immigration document, MoD Form 90 (Defence Identity Card)

National Identity Card issued by an EEA state, Electoral Identity Card issued in Northern Ireland

Voter Authority Certificate, Anonymous Electors Document

If you don't have an acceptable form of voter ID you can apply for a free Voter ID document

You can still use out of date Photo ID so long as it looks like you

The name on the ID should be the same name you used to register to vote.
