Dear All,

Do you like decorating Christmas Trees?

We are holding a Christmas Tree Festival in St. Helen's Church, Stickford on Saturday 9th December and Sunday 10th December. This would be similar to a flower festival, but there would be Christmas trees to look at, rather than flower displays. The trees will remain in the church until after the Carol Service on 16th December.

Each organisation, business or individual family is invited to decorate a tree on the theme of their choice - for example a nature club may choose to decorate their tree with natural objects such as pine cones, nuts etc.

We would ask you to purchase a tree from us (approx. height 1.25m to 1.5m, subsidised cost £13), which you decorate in the church and can then keep after the Carol Service on 16th December, or the tree can be auctioned off to raise further money. You will need battery powered lights, which are readily available, as there are limited electricity sockets in the church.

Please let us know whether you would be interested in taking part in this event. It is 25 years since we last held one in 1998, and we would very much like it to be a success.
