#### Do you like decorating Christmas Trees?

We are holding a Christmas Tree Festival in St. Helen's Church, Stickford on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> December and Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> December. This would be similar to a flower festival, but there would be Christmas trees to look at, rather than flower displays. The trees will remain in the church until after the Carol Service on 16<sup>th</sup> December.
