Church Bookshop

Thank you for your continued support for our bookshop. It's great that so many of you are buying books and then returning them for someone else to read. However, we have become a victim of our own success and unfortunately, we don't have the space to display all the books that are being donated and have had to give some away. Also, we cannot display books that are torn or hardbacked books that are missing their dustjackets; so please only donate books in good condition, from smoke free homes.

There are also limits to the categories we can display, so we have had to choose the most popular. Our current categories are:

Also, there is a bookshop at Gunby Hall, you can drop books off with the carpark attendant – again please only books in good condition – but they can accept a wider range of categories than we can.

Stickford Charities

Stickford Relief in Need Charity makes school clothing grants in the summer term to parents of children aged 4-16 (plus older children who still need to wear a school uniform) living in the parish of £75 per child to be spent at Nationwide School Uniforms in Spilsby or in the school shoe and uniform department at Oldrids Downtown.

The vouchers can be split in £25 amounts between either Oldrids Downtown or NSU as parents prefer. Please make sure you state how many of each voucher you require when you apply.

Please apply in writing stating the child's name, date of birth and YOUR FULL CONTACT DETAILS to Mrs Pam Bryant, Beauport, Cul-de-sac, Stickford by Sunday 9th June 2024.

Please note that for administrative reasons applications received after **Sunday 9th June 2024** cannot be considered. **No reminders will be given this year**.

Applicants will only be notified if their application has **NOT** been successful. Vouchers will be available for successful applicants to collect from the Community Centre on **Wednesday 10th July 2024** for one hour **from 6.30 to 7.30 p.m.**

NSU vouchers will have to be spent by the end of September 2024. The Oldrids vouchers can, as usual, **only** be spent in the following Oldrids Downtown departments: **school clothing and children's shoes.** These departments may not be available at Oldrids over the Christmas period. Recipients will be asked to sign for each Oldrids voucher received against the specific number of voucher issued so as to ensure this can be tracked as having been spent in the correct departments only. This is in order to comply with our charitable status.

If you do not wish to spend your vouchers in the relevant departments at Oldrids Downtown, please do not apply for their vouchers.

Stickford Relief in Need Charity exists to provide financial help for those in need living in the parish of Stickford, as well as providing school clothing vouchers, birth grants and cash payments to pensioners and others in need at Christmas. The Trustees welcome applications from any resident for assistance with, for example, repair bills, funeral expenses, aids for disabled people etc.

The Charity also once again provides a bus service twice a month - to Boston on the second Wednesday and Horncastle on the fourth Thursday of the month, for those without access to their own transport and those who can show a genuine need to use the service, even if they have their own transport as well. Have you bought a ticket yet for the **South and East Lindsey Community Lottery?** It is an exciting weekly lottery that raises money for Stickford Community Centre and other good causes.

Tickets for the lottery cost just £1 a week. Each ticket has a **1 in 50** chance to win a prize each week, with a top prize of £25,000! That's a better chance of winning than the National Lottery or the Health Lottery.

Each ticket has six numbers and each number is between 0 and 9. There will be a draw every Saturday night when a six digit winning combination will be picked. Prizes will be given to players with tickets that match the first or last 2 to 6 numbers from the winning combination. Match all six and you win the jackpot!
