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- a) **A resident reported that the public footpath between Back Lane and Hagnaby Road is overgrown.** Another resident reported that it has been cleared during the past couple of days.
 - b) **A resident reported that issues are still arising at the airfield with the amount of scrap metal and scrap wood, along with the loose dog.** Cllr Hume took the details and will follow it up to see if she can have some influence.
 - c) **A resident reported that the state of the road along Fen Road and the Cul De Sac is poor. Some potholes have been patched as a result of reporting on Fix My Street, but not all of them.** Cllr Hume will investigate with Highways.
 - d) **A resident reported that the hedge next to the junction of Fen Road and the Cul De Sac is becoming overgrown, obscuring vision to drivers.** Cllr Reeson to investigate to check if it is a private residence or Highways responsibility.
 - e) **A resident reported that the curbs on the central reservation on the A16 are too high when using a wheelchair. It makes it a very dangerous place for all wheelchair users when attempting to cross the main A16.** Cllr Hume will investigate with Highways and see if an up-to-date Speed Survey could be carried out.
